

INCOME ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES Effective from July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015

The eligibility scale is for determining the participant’s eligibility category for federal meal reimbursement. Participants from households with total gross incomes at or below the following levels may be eligible for Tier I reimbursement rates.

Note: Recipients of the following programs are automatically eligible for Tier I reimbursement rates:

- CalFresh Program (formerly known as Food Stamps)
- California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids Program (CalWORKs)
- Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservation (FDPIR)
- Foster Care Program
- Head Start or Even Start
- Kinship Guardianship Assistance Payment (Kin-GAP)
